THANK YOU The Chairman thanked Cllr Thorpe (BPC) and Cllr Penwarden (NFDC) for their hard work during their terms of office; neither will be standing for another term.

ELECTIONS 5 nomination papers were received by NFDC for the 6 Parish Councillor positions available for the new term of office in Burley. This means that a Parish Council election will not be necessary and the 5 candidates will be automatically elected on 7th May 2015. A 6th Councillor is being sought for co-option. BROADBAND Glenn Peacey from HCC and John Taylor from Openreach attended the meeting to discuss the superfast Broadband programme that is being implemented across Hampshire. Two boxes are planned for Burley, however significant location problems for the new Superfast Broadband boxes were highlighted. Openreach are looking for private land to site the boxes on that are approx. 1200mm by 250mm in size. The location must be within 50m of the current box site. Once

installed, an improved broadband service will be seen up to 1200m from the boxes. The first of Burley's planned boxes is hoped to be installed by the end of this year if a suitable location can be found. The second will be part of Phase 2 next year. If you would like to know whether your postcode will be covered by these planned improvements visit the HCC website and enter your postcode for an update.

ROADS AND TRAFFIC Cllr Martin reported that: Zigzag lines outside the primary school are to be repainted. Double yellow lines from the Queens Head to the primary school have been requested via the police traffic management department to Hampshire Highways. A request for repair of the cattle grid at Warnes Lane has been submitted. Potholes: repairs are ongoing.

PLAY AREA A concept document is being worked on for a children's play area and will be passed to the new Parish Council for further development
