It was noted that the Public Hearing of the Appeal against Refusal of Permission in respect of Planning Application No. 14/01027 for the extension to Gorselands Nursing Home is expected to take place at 10.00 a.m. on Tuesday 11th August 2015 at Lymington Town Hall. Further written representations have now been made by BPC & villagers to the Inspector.

BROADBAND Discussions for the possible location of the proposed Superfast Broadband (SFBB) cabinet in the village centre is progressing between Openreach and Wathen Bartlett Club. A second cabinet location is being investigated in Lester Square either opposite the telephone box, next to the bench seat or just down Mill Lane opposite the entrance to Benedicts. Progress with the SFBB project is being closely monitored by BPC. Watch this space for further information!

ROADS AND TRAFFIC Cllr Martin reported that: a traffic engineer from NFDC will carry out a site assessment for "No waiting at any time" double yellow lines on the hill up towards the primary school. The proposed A338 improvements work is due to run from

September 2015 to May 2016. This involves a 5.5 mile stretch from the Ashley Heath roundabout to the Blackwater junction. One carriageway will be worked on at a time and speed limits will be reduced to 40mph. Cllr Martin is in correspondence with both Dorset and Hampshire Highways in order to understand their contingency planning to deal with traffic congestion on the A31.
