LOCAL CRIME UPDATE PCSO Tracey Cooper reported that there has been very little crime in Burley of late; this is good news for us all! There have been 2 shed break-ins (nothing was taken); a slight increase in car park crime early in the season: the Police will be patrolling car parks to keep abreast of this; and 2 incidents of fly tipping. Significantly, NFDC recently fined fly tippers who dumped 200kg of rubbish at Vereley car park; the rubbish was traced back to a Bournemouth business that could not prove that they arranged for proper disposal of the waste.

ROADS AND TRAFFIC Work to repair the drain and sink hole in Burley Park has now been completed. Following the recent heavy rain there has not been any further flooding in the village, demonstrating that recent drain clearance works through the village has alleviated previous problems, at least for the time being. BPC continues to monitor this.

CYCLING The Wiggle Spring Sportive will run through Burley on 7/8th April between 8.40am and 11.25am. BPC are in discussion with the organisers (UK Cycling Events), the Safety Advisory Group and the NFNPA to highlight that this is also Palm Sunday and that the usual procession from the Parish Church to the War Memorial (and back along Chapel Lane) will be taking place that morning.

LITTER PICK, Please do join us for our part of the **Great British Spring Clean** this year. The date is **Sunday 23rd April**. We will start **outside Burley Primary School at 2.30 p.m.** so that you can work on your individually preferred areas for an hour or so.

As usual, we are looking for lots of volunteers to join us then and help pick up as much litter as possible in the areas of the Forest around the village and out as far as Picket Post, Holmsley, Burbush & Woods Corner. Gloves, sacks and litter grabbers will be provided (but you are welcome to bring your own kit). Young & old alike are welcome but children will need to be accompanied at all stages.

ANNUAL ASSEMBLY REMINDER! **Monday 24th April at 7.30pm** is the date set for this year's Parish Assembly hosted by B.P.C. Everyone in the Parish is invited to attend what is effectively Burley village's Annual General Meeting in the Village Hall, Pound Lane.
