SUPERFAST BROADBAND Openreach are currently awaiting permission for provision of power to the new Superfast Broadband cabinet, which has agreed permission for installation at Lester Square. We will continue to keep you updated of any progress as we continue to do all we can to support this service that is vital to local residents and businesses.

ROADS AND TRAFFIC There will be a road closure at the North end of Bisterne Close from 2 weeks from 10th July; this is due to drainage works.

BENCHES Some of you may have noticed that two benches have been removed from Burley Street. This is due to rotting wooden slats and degradation of the metal reinforcements in the concrete bench ends. BPC is currently investigating new oak replacements, which will be in-keeping with the forest environment. Watch this space!
