ROADS AND TRAFFIC Hampshire Highways (HH) will soon be making some improvements to the road between the Queens Head and Chapel Lane; the road will be levelled, holes filled and the verge infilled. The Lengthsman will then cut back the brambles along the same stretch of road. HH will also be providing reflectors for the pinch points in the village which the Lengthsman will fit.

LENGTHSMAN Our Lengthsman Jono has been doing a great job around the village for the last few months and is really making a difference to the look of the village.
