NFDC SUSPENSION OF CAR PARKING CHARGES In support of Small Business Saturday NFDC will be suspending car parking charges on **2nd December**. In addition to this, parking charges in NFDC car parks will also be suspended on the last weekend before Christmas: **23rd and 24th December**.

YOUTH OF BURLEY GRANT A grant of £200 was given to the Youth of Burley. This grant has been increased since last year in recognition of the valuable work that is done by the organisers with the young people of our village.

PROPOSED CLOSURE OF PART OF HOLMSLEY PASSAGE Following a proposal by the Verderers to return Highways land to Forest land at the northern extent of Holmsley passage, BPC will be communicating that it will not support the closing of Holmsley Passage as this is a well-used local route.

PROTOCOL IN THE EVENT OF DEATH OF A SENIOR ROYAL At the request of NFDC, BPC will prepare a protocol in the event of the death of a Senior Royal. This will include a Book of Condolence, lowering of the Union Flag to half-mast and flowers may be laid at The Cross.
