“DIG BURLEY” PROJECT James Brown, community architect for NFNPA, visited BPC to outline a community Test Pitting project in Burley; this will be funded by the Heritage Lottery and the NFNPA. The project in Burley will be a pilot for the New Forest and will take place for 3 days during this October half-term holiday. Volunteers will receive a guidance pack and dig a 1 metre cube hole in their gardens to look for historical artefacts and identify past human activity. Look out for further details.
