WW1 COMMEMORATIONS The Chairman wishes to thank all those who took part in and successfully organised Burley's WW1 Remembrance commemorations. BPC contributed to the commemorations on 11<sup>th</sup> November by providing the Orders of Service and also by contributing to "Keep The Home Fires Burning", performed in Burley Church to packed audiences. In the near future BPC is intending to replace a bench in Pound Lane - this will be dedicated with a plaque in memory of the Fallen of WW1 and WW2. As you may also be aware BPC has been facilitating the addition of two names to the War Memorial; we are currently awaiting Planning Permission approval to make this alteration to our village's listed monument.

CASUAL VACANCY Due to the resignation of Cllr Kendall a casual vacancy has arisen for a Councillor on BPC. Our thanks go to Jane Kendall for her contribution to the village as a Parish Councillor. Mrs Kendall will continue to hold the village Welcome Packs. A notice of vacancy has been displayed on the BPC noticeboards and on the BPC website: if by 20<sup>th</sup> November 2018 a request for an election to fill the vacancy is made in writing to the Returning Officer (NFDC), by ten electors for the Parish, an election will be held to fill the vacancy. If no request for an election is received the vacancy will be filled by co-option. In this instance, for anyone already thinking of trying their hand at being a Burley Parish Councillor, the co-option process may be seen as a useful precursor experience prior to the local elections due to take place in May next year.
